The May camp at Walton Firs included a visit to a working water mill, Crate Staking and artificial caves and tunnels. At the Sixers and Seconders camp at Jordan Heights, the Cubs put up their own tents, learnt to climb on a rock face and cooked their own meals. We held joint activity evenings with both our Scouts and 2nd Reigate (Earlswood) Cubs. The Cubs visited Reigate Fire Station and Town Hall (and met the Mayor!), a Hindu Temple as part of World Faith Badge and completed a Town Trail in Reigate. We reached the Semi-finals of the District Football competition. .

Autumn started with an introduction to First Aid followed by the group camp at Park Farm, Banstead. We reached a number of the finals in the District Go-Karts. The Cubs won the County Cooking Competition. We has a Festival of Lights for Divali and looked at the Firework Code. The Cubs completed stage 2 of the Emergency Aid Badge. We had a joint night with the Beavers and a tour of the Town Hall. This term finished with singing carols at a sheltered accommodation in Horley and Ice Skating in Reigate Priory Park.
